**Whistle-blowing** is when a somebody tells a person in charge about something bad going



If staff are not following the rules in these booklets you can tell a support worker or a manager




Often, it is a member of staff who is doing this bad thing. It may even be a manager.



or you can make a complaint.



We want everybody who works for Dimensions to know that it's good to speak up when something bad is going on.

We call the person who speaks up a **whistle-blower**.
